Cameron anchored the Esk Valley team in to win the men's team award ahead of Pickering and their respective 'B' teams.

In the women Kay Neesam and Aly Raw were not far apart in the early stages of the race. Kay soon warmed up however and moved ahead on the first climb with Kim England in third. As they passed Dunsdale Pond at the top Kay had established a lead of about 90 seconds. She went on to win ahead of Aly Raw and Rhonna Haslam in third. Indeed it was Rhonna and her mother Sue, who anchored Scarborough to a win in the team event.
